Selected list of skill for Dental Graduates: DRAFT

- 1. Perform complete oral examination and diagnose dental and common oral diseases
- 2. Formulate a treatment plan for common dental (Dental caries and its sequelae, malocclusion, periodontitis) and oral mucosal diseases (aphthous ulcer, herpes simplex, traumatic ulcer, gingivitis)
- 3. Referral of cases to specialists when needed or follow-up protocol.
- 4. Fabricate removable appliances for the management of simple malocclusion.
- 5. Assessment of patients with oral manifestation of systemic diseases and refer appropriately
- 6. Assessment of patients with fascial space infections and its management
- 7. Projects and processes intraoral radiographs
- 8. Interprets intraoral and extraoral radiographs
- 9. Interprets basic laboratory investigations
- 10. Demonstrates local anesthetic injections techniques in cast/models
- 11. Performs Exercises in phantom head (Crown preparation/Cavity preparation)
- 12. Identify files and canals in extracted tooth
- 13. Applies Rubber dam, adapts matrix band for restoration, applies wedge for restoration
- 14. Mixes GIC using appropriate technique
- 15. Restore a tooth with GIC, composite, amalgam
- 16. Age estimation using cast/photographs or scenario
- 17. Eruption pattern and sequence using casts or picture
- 18. Identification of specific cells characteristic of the pathology
- 19. Identification of special stains used; in photographs or slides
- 20. Recognize head and neck pathology
- 21. Performs dressing of wounds
- 22. Writes prescription for a patient with common oral mucosal and dental diseases.
- 23. Perform/Demonstrate ART, ACT, OUT and Pit and Fissure sealant
- 24. Record dental indices
- 25. Perform/Demonstrate standard precaution procedures and disposal of dental waste
- 26. Formulate and execute treatment for partially and fully edentulous cases with heat-cured acrylic resin prostheses
- 27. Perform tooth preparation in typodont for receiving cast restorations
- 28. Classify partially edentulous cases and design suitable cast partial denture on the dental casts
- 29. Diagnose and deliver non-surgical periodontal treatments to patients with periodontal diseases.

- 30. Advice patient about basic oral and periodontal hygiene measures.
- 31. Perform pediatric tooth restoration
- 32. Deliver basic oral and dental care in pediatric patients
- 33. Make needful behavioral and management modifications where needed (in reference to pediatric dentistry and special needs dentistry)
- 34. Demonstrates BP, pulse, Oxygen saturation measurement
- 35. Performs CPR using bag and mask
- 36. Demonstrates Assessment of brain stem functions
- 37. Detect signs of raised intracranial pressure
- 38. Demonstrates/ Performs IV cannulation and venous blood sampling
- 39. Demonstrates/ Performs Hand washing
- 40. Demonstrates/ Performs Gloving technique
- 41. Demonstrates/ Performs gowning
- 42. Calculates drug dosage correctly and writes prescription for a person with a given problem
- 43. Removal of foreign body intraorally/Aspiration of instruments
- 44. Suturing of skin and oral mucosa
- 45. Take informed consent for surgery and dental procedures under LA/GA
- 46. Demonstrates/ Performs Cranial nerve examination
- 47. Assessing level of consciousness/ Glasgow coma scale
- 48. Performs Primary trauma care- PTC (primary survey- ABCDE of trauma)
- 49. Triaging of patients
- 50. Donning of PPE
- 51. X-ray interpretation of common conditions (Pneumonia, pneumothorax, pleural effusion, cardiomegaly, intestinal obstruction, perforation, fractures)
- 52. Perform/demonstrates intramuscular, intravenous, subcutaneous injection
- 53. Perform/demonstrate Incision and drainage of simple abscess
- 54. Interpretation of basic lab investigations
